The Fresh Air Market is a fundraising event for the Tallapoosa County Girls Ranch. The money raised will come solely from vendor fees, Boston Butt Plate Sales, and the Ducky Race. Our guest will have to pay to enter the state park at its regular rate of \$4 an adult, \$2 Seniors or \$2 a child. Vendors will enter for free. This even is backed by the Auburn Opelika Tourism bureau. The FAM Event will be advertised on the radio, bill boards, newspapers, parenting magazine, Multiple Facebook pages, etc. For this time of year, the park will on average have 800 guests on Saturday and 500 guests on Sunday. This will be a great opportunity to promote your business and unique items to the public.

Your set-up space will be 15' x 15'. Tents and canopies are permitted within this space. If your set-up is any larger than this, you must purchase an additional space. There are very limited spaces available with electrical hook up options. However, you must provide your own extensions cords of at least 75 ft. Spaces are assigned on a first come, first served basis as applications are received.

You can set up Friday between 4-7pm or Saturday morning between 7-8:30 am . A Festival Committee member will be available to assist you on site.

As you enter the State Park you will receive your pre-assigned space number and parking pass. Vendor's will not have to pay an entry fee at the gate. For safety reasons strict parking regulations must be followed and your parking pass must be visible.

- Application deadline for non-profit organizations, crafts, and food vendors is April 15th, 2018.
- Non-electric spaces are priced at \$50 for the entirety of the event. There will be a \$10 late fee applied to applications received after the deadline.
- 501(c) 3 Non-profit organizations will be provided a 15'x15' non-electric space at no cost
- Power will be available on a first come, first serve basis. These sites are priced at \$75 for the entirety of the event. Electricity needs must be indicated on your application and you must supply your own heavy-duty 75 foot cord.
- Payment in full is due with your application. Your receipt of payment will be verified through email. You will not be permitted to set up unless your fee is paid in full.
- Payments are non-refundable. Rain-Out Days are scheduled for May 26th and 27th
- Participation will be denied for anyone submitting a NSF (non-sufficient funds) check.

VENDOR PARTICPATION:

- All vendors must be in their designated space and ready for the festival to begin at 9AM
- For Safety reasons: Under no circumstances will you be permitted to drive through the festival grounds after starting times. Vendors are asked not to leave until the end of the festival hours except in cases of emergency. Please notify the Festival Committee if you must leave before the end of festival hours.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages are permitted on the premises.
- The FAM committee and/or Chewacla State Park are not responsible for any damaged,lost, or stolen items.
- All Park Rules must be adhered to
- Please notify the FAM Committee ahead of time as to any special needs or handicapped as we have limited space.

VENDOR SPACES AND MERCHANDISE:

- You must stay in your allotted space. No unapproved signage permitted outside of your assigned spot.
- You cannot change your assigned spot on your own. Consult with the FAM Committee on any issues.
- Please indicate on your application the items which will be prepared and sold at the festival. Be specific when listing items on your application. If multiple vendors list the same product on their application, then the subsequent vendors will be notified that product is already being sold at the festival. We will do our best to make sure two of the identical products (I.e. "It Works", "Posh", "Tupperware" , ETC.)are not sold by multiple vendors at the festival.
- The Girls Ranch will be selling Boston Butts, BBQ plates,

The festival Committee reserves the right to reject an application and return all fees. You will be notified of you application acceptance by April 30th, 2018 along with further details regarding the event. We also reserve the right to accept a limited number of vendors with a similar product.
